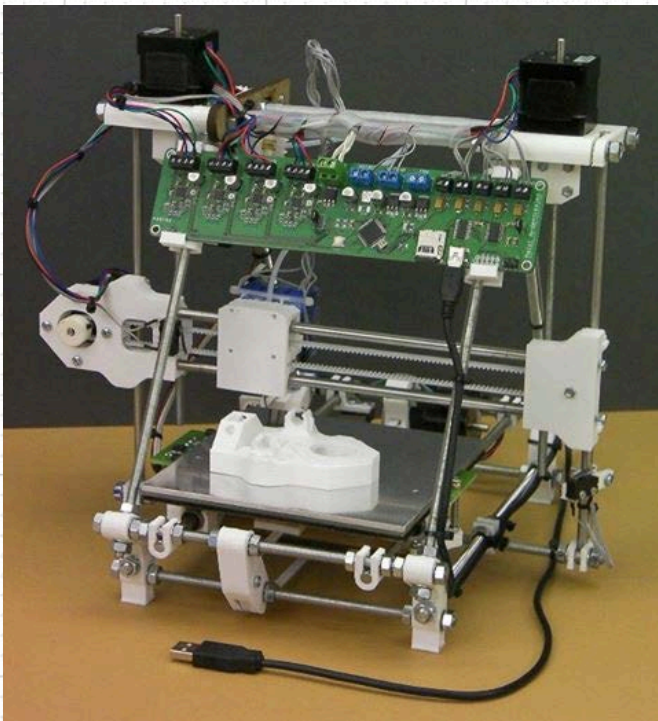




# Building 3D printers with social scientists
